

New Tardy Policy for Spring 2007

The tardy policy at FWBHS has been revised 2nd semester to eliminate disruptions to the classroom learning environment caused by student tardiness. This policy starts Tuesday, January 9, 2007. If you have any questions concerning this new policy, contact Joe Peterson at 833-3300, extension 3326.

1. Students will have the first 5 days of the semester to work a routine for getting to class on time. Students having any recurring problems during the first five days should contact their discipline administrator immediately.
2. Starting on the 6th day of the semester any student in the hall after the tardy bell ringing will not be permitted in class without a pass/admit. Students who are tardy to class must report to the cafeteria to check in with the tardy detention monitor.
3. Students who have less than 4 tardies will be given a “tardy admit” to allow them to enter class.
4. Students who have 4 or more tardies will remain in the cafeteria for detention. Students will not be allowed to sleep, talk, listen to music, or play video games during detention.
5. Parents will be notified, by automated attendant, that their child missed a class period due to tardiness. Parents should talk with their child and contact their child’s discipline administrator should the tardiness continue.
6. When students miss class for their 4th and 5th tardies, the absence will not count against them, and they can make up their work within one school day. It will be the student’s responsibility to find out what he/she has missed. Students will not be allowed to make up their work during class time.
7. When students miss class for their 6th and each subsequent tardy, the student will be charged with an unexcused absence and will receive a zero for all work missed.
